The UC Davis Study Group on Accessibility and Affordability was formed in 2011 in response to the new financial challenges facing not only the UC Davis campus, but the entire public education system. The goal of the study group was to create a formal mechanism for evaluating suggestions on how to increase accessibility and affordability, as well as develop additional ideas, strategies, initiatives, programs, and practices that could help expand access to excellent public higher education at UC Davis and in California.

Professor Ann Huff Stevens is the Director of the Center for Poverty Research at UC Davis and Professor and Chair of the Department of Economics. She studies low-income workers and labor markets, the incidence and effects of job loss, connections between economic shocks and health, and poverty and safety net dynamics. In addition, in 2011 Professor Stevens was appointed the Chair of the UC Davis Study Group on Accessibility and Affordability. Professor Stevens will be presenting the findings from the UC Davis Study Group alongside several UC Davis students who will share their own experiences and thoughts on accessibility and affordability at UC Davis.
